FAIR PLAY CODE FOR PARENTS:

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports
2. I will remember that my child plays sport for his or her enjoyment
3. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence
4. I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the race.
5. I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and trying hard.
6. I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake for losing a competition or race.
7. I will remember that children learn best by example. I will applaud good performance by both my child and opponents.
8. I will never question the official's judgment or honesty in public.
9. I will support all efforts to remove verbal abuse and physical abuse from children's sporting events.
10. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches, board members, officials and other volunteers who give their time to provide sport activities for my child.
